TOWNSHIP OF LAPEER BRIDGE ORDINANCE

Ordinance No. 21.1

An Ordinance to protect the public health and safety by prohibiting persons from engaging in fishing, swimming, diving, boat launching and loitering on bridges located within the Township of Lapeer.

THE TOWNSHIP OF LAPEER ORDAINS:

Section 1 PROHIBITED USES OF BRIDGES

No person shall engage in fishing, swimming, diving, boat launching or loitering on any bridge located on a public road within the Township of Lapeer.

Section 2 PENALTY

Any person, firm or corporation who violates any of the provisions of this ordinance will be held responsible for a municipal civil infraction and for creating a public nuisance, subject to payment of a civil fine of not less than \$50.00, plus costs and other sanctions, for each infraction. Repeat offenses under this ordinance shall be subject to increased fines as provided for in the Lapeer Township Civil Infraction Ordinance.

Section 3 REPEAL

The former Lapeer Township Bridge Ordinance, being Ordinance No. 21 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 4 EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance was adopted by the Lapeer Township Board at a meeting duly held on the 14th day of November 2011 and was published in the LAView newspaper on the 24th day of November 2011. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after the date of publication.
