Sub Area Planning Districts

In addition to the general land use plan in the preceding chapter, the Master Plan also provides more specific analysis for several areas of the Township. The Master Plan provides four (4) sub area plans for those areas of the Township which have been identified as being the main potential growth and redevelopment areas.


