TOWNSHIP OF LAPEER FIRE RUN INCIDENTS FEE SCHEDULE

Class A - Fire Department Response: Typically are responses that require the largest number of personnel and equipment; such as structure fires, vehicle fires on private property, grass fires, electrical related incidents (downed wires, arcing wires, pole fires, etc.) and any other Fire Department response not specifically enumerated in the other response classifications.

- \$ 500.00 resident
- \$3,000.00 non-resident

Class B - Fire Department Response: Typically include Rescue responses, washdowns, and: vehicle fires on a public roadway. Rescue responses are defined as an emergency or non-emergency situation in which the need for the Fire Department's rescue related equipment is the primary reason for the response. Automobile extrication, confined space rescue calls, and carbon monoxide responses requiring more resources than the Fire Department Duty Officer are included in this category. A wash down is defined as a nonemergency situation, normally requiring only a single truck response.

- \$ 500.00 resident
- \$1,000.00 non-resident

Class C - Fire Department Response: Calls in this category require only the response of the Fire Department's Duty Officer. These calls typically include carbon monoxide alarms, outdoor burning complaints, and minor smoke investigations (this list is not all inclusive).

- ZERO (0) RESIDENT UP TO TWO CALLS IN A 12 MONTH PERIOD
- \$500.00 RESIDENT, MORE THAN TWO CALLS IN ANY 12 MONTH PERIOD
- \$600.00 non-resident/commercial/industrial

Class D - Fire Department Response: Calls in this category are limited to False Alarms. False alarms shall include any situation in which an alarm has been received Lapeer County Central Dispatch (911) and the Fire Department's personnel have been notified to respond and it is determined that the alarm or the reason for the call is false. This may include vehicle incidents or calls in which the Fire Department response is cancelled after being dispatched.

- ZERO (0) RESIDENT UP TO TWO CALLS IN A 12 MONTH PERIOD
- \$500.00 resident, more than two calls in any 12 month period.
- \$1,000.00 non-resident may include vehicle dispatch.

Class E - Hazmat:

• \$5,000.00 hazmat (plus any additional fees incurred for cleanup)

Class F - Illegal Burn / No burn permit.

• \$75.00

Fees for fire run incidents' for parcels that are "exempt" from the Public Safety Special Assessment District shall be as follows:

- Class A: \$ 2,500.00
- Class B \$ 750.00
- Class C \$ 500.00
- Class D \$ 500.00 up to two calls in a 12 month period
 - \$ 750.00 more than two calls in any 12 month period
